BALATON BEYOND the BEACH

WINE & VOLCANOES

1 day

Discover the volcanic landscapes and celebrated wines of Badacsony on a carefully curated day trip from Budapest. Begin with a guided hike on Szent György Hill, taking in its striking basalt formations and panoramic views over Lake Balaton and the surrounding vineyards. After a locally prepared lunch in nature, continue to Váli Winery for an estate and cellar visit, followed by a tasting of 8–9 selected wines paired with a refined selection of local dishes.

A thoughtfully designed introduction to the natural beauty, wine culture and gastronomy of the Balaton wine region.



SZENT GYÖRGY HILL – guided hike among ancient volcanic basalt formations and vineyards

LOCAL LUNCH IN NATURE – packed lunch prepared with fresh, local ingredients

VÁLI WINERY – estate and historic cellar visit

WINE & GASTRONOMY – tasting of 8–9 selected wines paired with cold and hot appetisers, a wood-fired main course and dessert

PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION – private transfer to and from the railway station in Badacsonytomaj



HIDDEN BALATON

WINE, VOLCANOES, LAVENDER & CYCLING EXPERIENCE

4 days / 3 nights

Experience the refined and lesser-known side of Lake Balaton, where exceptional wines, volcanic landscapes and local traditions come together. From the vineyards and basalt formations of the Badacsony wine region to the peaceful shores of the lake, this journey combines carefully selected wine experiences with active discovery and authentic local encounters.

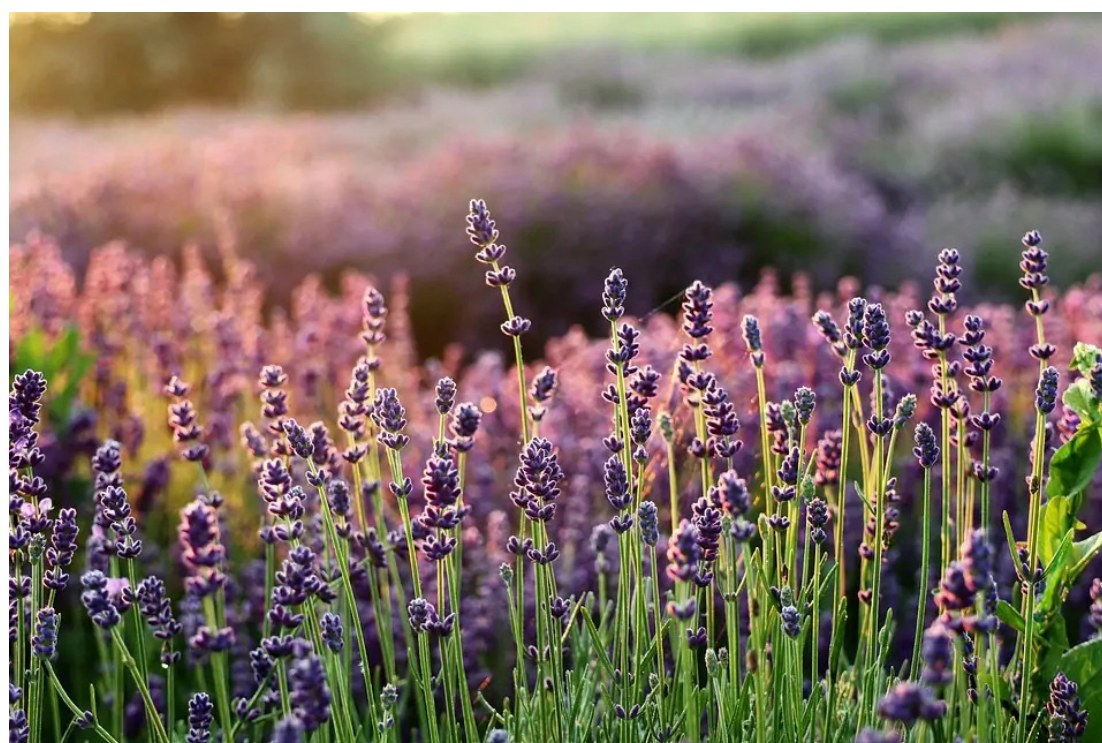


VÁLI WINERY EXPERIENCE – estate and cellar visit followed by a tasting of 8–9 selected wines, paired with a seasonal meal and local specialities

SZENT GYÖRGY HILL – guided hike among its remarkable volcanic basalt formations, with panoramic views over Lake Balaton and the surrounding vineyards

E-BIKE TOUR THROUGH THE VOLCANIC HILLS – a scenic 28 km ride through vineyards, historic villages and distinctive natural landscapes

TIHANY LAVENDER EXPERIENCE – visit to a family-run artisan distillery, with tastings of lavender syrups, teas and handmade sweets



TIME BY LAKE BALATON – opportunities for swimming, paddling or simply enjoying the lakeside at leisure

STAY IN BADACSONYTOMAJ – 3 nights at Villa Bella, overlooking the vineyards and Lake Balaton

WINE REGIONS, LIVING TRADITIONS & GASTRONOMY

3 days / 2 nights

Discover Northern Hungary through its wines, culinary traditions and living cultural heritage. From Budapest’s vibrant café culture to the villages and vineyards of the Tokaj wine region, this carefully curated journey combines intimate local encounters, exceptional gastronomy and distinctive landscapes. Meet local artisans in Tard, explore Tokaj from the water and enjoy a private winery experience before discovering the historic city of Eger.



BUDAPEST – thematic walk through the Jewish Quarter, exploring café culture, local flavours and the city’s distinctive atmosphere

MATYÓ TRADITIONS IN TARD – meet local women, discover traditional embroidery and enjoy a hands-on workshop followed by a regional lunch

BODROG RIVER – peaceful boat cruise through the vineyards, wetlands and natural landscapes of the Tokaj Wine Region

TOKAJ WINE EXPERIENCE – private winery visit, guided tasting of selected wines and seasonal dinner in an intimate vineyard setting

EGER – explore the historic Baroque centre, including Eger Castle, the Basilica and Minaret, followed by lunch at Michelin-starred Macok Bistro

THOUGHTFUL ACCOMMODATION – one night in a centrally located 4-star hotel in Budapest and one night in a beautifully restored winegrower’s guesthouse in Mád.

BUDAPEST, CYCLING DISCOVERY & LIVING TRADITIONS IN ŐRSÉG

4 days / 3 nights



Discover a quieter and more authentic side of Hungary, combining the cultural energy of Budapest with the landscapes, flavours and traditions of Őrség National Park. From a private Danube cruise and a Michelin-starred dining experience to scenic e-bike rides, traditional crafts and local wine, this journey offers an intimate introduction to a region where rural traditions remain part of everyday life.

BUDAPEST – guided exploration of the historic city centre and private Danube cruise

ŐRSÉG NATIONAL PARK – discover its villages, forests, meadows and distinctive cultural heritage

WINE & GASTRONOMY – Michelin-starred four-course lunch at Pajta Restaurant and tasting of six Bussay wines, including local grape varieties

E-BIKE EXPLORATION – guided 42 km ride through the rolling landscapes and villages of Őrség

LIVING TRADITIONS – discover pottery, pumpkin seed oil production, leathercraft and traditional blacksmithing

LOCAL FLAVOURS – regional cuisine, homemade specialities and a traditional countryside dining experience

THOUGHTFUL ACCOMMODATION – one night in Budapest followed by two nights in a panoramic guesthouse in Őriszentpéter, with sauna and jacuzzi

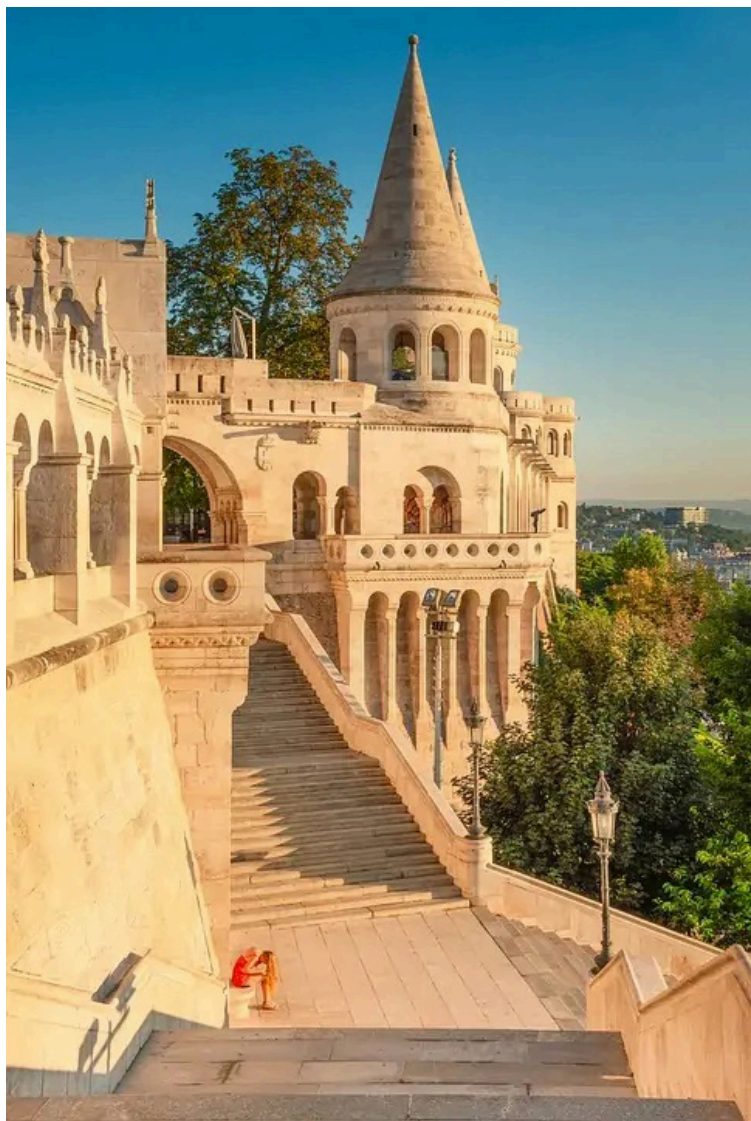

BUDAPEST – PÉCS – MECSEK HILLS —

4 days / 3 nights



Discover Southern Hungary through a balanced combination of cultural heritage, nature and seasonal gastronomy. From the vibrant streets of Budapest to the forested landscapes of the Mecsek Hills and the historic city of Pécs, this journey offers a relaxed introduction to a lesser-known side of Hungary, with thoughtful experiences rooted in local traditions and the natural environment.

BUDAPEST – guided exploration of the city's historic centre and an evening Danube cruise

MECSEK HILLS – discover the landscapes around Lake Orfű and stay in a family-run eco-friendly guesthouse

WILD FOOD & LOCAL GASTRONOMY – guided foraging walk followed by a hands-on farm-to-fork lunch experience using seasonal local ingredients

LAKE ORFŰ – gentle stand-up paddle experience surrounded by the forested hills of the Mecsek

PÉCS – explore the city's UNESCO-listed Early Christian Necropolis, historic monuments and Zsolnay Cultural Quarter

LOCAL FLAVOURS – countryside dining accompanied by a regional wine tasting or herbal drink experience
